At Homelands Primary School we recognise the contribution of physical activity to the health and well-being of the children. We believe that a varied P.E. curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities will have a positive influence on the children's concentration, attitude and academic achievement.

### CURRICULUM ENRICHMENT

Specialist coaches supported staff in their delivery of PE lessons for 1 session a week for all year groups throughout the year. This input improved children's skills and confidence as well as teacher knowledge and confidence in delivering specific units. A health and physical activity day in Autumn 2015 gave each year group, including F1 and F2, the opportunity to have a specialist coach delivering some different sports including dance in F1 and F2, handball in Years 2, 3 and 4 and Fencing and Archery in year 6.

### HEALTHY SCHOOL

Healthy cookery clubs for both Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 children continue. Children learn about nutrition and make their own healthy meals and snacks.  
Two members of staff attended Change 4 Life training along with four year 5 children. Some A Change for Life session for year 3 children has been delivered by a local coach  
A Sporty Lunchtime Club has been run, every Friday, by the Arsenal Sports Coach and supported by Sports Ambassadors in years 5 and 6.

### COMPETITIVE OPPORTUNITIES

We have joined the Torbay School Partnership Family Cluster to promote competitive opportunities across the school for all children from F2 to Year 6. Children have taken part in focus sports and festivals with local schools, including Sports Hall Athletics for years 3,4 and 6, A Games for less sporty children in year 3, multi-skills for reception and year 2, with year 2 progressing through to the final, volleyball for year 5 and rounders for year 6. Each event is preceded by some additional coaching from PE staff at St Cuthbert Mayne Secondary School.

### SPORTS WEEK

The whole school took part in a week of sport activities with the four school houses competing with each other throughout the school. All the school wore Tee shirts corresponding to the colours of their house. Each key stage had an afternoon where parents were invited to watch individual and team races. Parents and staff also had the opportunity to compete against each other.

### POSITIVE IMPACT

PE and Sports Premium has had a positive impact on the children. The children have been able to explore different sports and apply their skills to different experiences. They have had opportunities to experience being part of a team and competitions. All children belong to a school house and have their own team colour. Year 6 sports captains have been appointed to each house. Four sport ambassadors have been appointed from Years 5 and 6 and have received training in their roles from the Sports Partnership.
